





Concave Doors for Lucido, Lucido Senza, Opaco and Opaco Senza

There are three sizes of concave door: Small, Medium & Large. These enable the construction of four different concave installations. They are designed to work with 300mm deep wall units & 560mm deep base units.

The concave doors are all 715mm high to fit 720mm high cabinets & multiples thereof.

Concave cornices, pelmets & plinths are available to suit the concave doors as appropriate. Check the Price List for range availability.

The drawings here show the shapes & sizes of concave units to suit these doors, also how to set-out the concave units for installation.

The Bevelled Concave Door Edge & Hinges:

Concave doors have bevels down one of their rear vertical edges. This enables them to clear their neighbours as they are opened. Make sure that the drilling for hinges is down the opposite, square edge to the bevelled one!






Concave doors can be mounted on a wide range of 035mm concasled cup hinges - though it is recommended that wider opening angle versions are used to give best access to the concave cabinets.





For the curved plinths to fit properly, the rear of the plinths need to be 55mm from the fronts of the cabinets.









Convex Doors for all Ranges:

These Convex doors are 715mm high to fit 720mm high units with a radiused, quarter round shape. The smallest unit they will fit is 300m x 300mm deep. Convex comices, pelmets & plinths are available to suit. Check the Price List for range availability.

The convex cabinet radius varies according to the range design. Please refer to the chart for the correct radius.
